### VOTING PLACES

Voting places will be open for voting on Wednesday, October 24, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at:

Ward 1: St. Alphonse Hall  
Ward 3: Somerset Rendez Vous  
Ward 5: Somerset Rendez Vous

Ward 2: Swan Lake Friendship Centre  
Ward 4: Altamont Hall  
Ward 6: Club d'age d'or Notre Dame

**IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE.** A person may be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (i.e. driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

### ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at the Municipality of Lorne Municipal Office located at 307-3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Somerset and will be open on Wednesday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

### MOBILE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but reside at a health care facility, a mobile voting station will be set up at the following health care facilities on Election Day:

- Lorne Memorial Hospital in Swan Lake from 9:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.
- The Notre Dame Foyer in Notre-Dame-de-Lourdes from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

### APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, or by fax to the Senior Election Official at 55 Rogers Street, Box 89, Notre Dame de Lourdes, MB, R0G 1M0, Fax# 204-248-7289. If applying in person, a voter may apply between September 26 to October 21, 2018. A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application. If applying by mail or fax, a voter must apply by October 21st. A voter applying by mail or fax will receive a sealed ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangements with the Senior Election Official.
